

PRIVACY POLICY

1. Introduction and Agreement

Thornton North Penrith Pty Ltd ACN 600 628 644 is a joint venture that has been established to develop the new urban community located in the heart of Penrith. We may also market our products and services.

This website ("Site") is operated by the legal owners of the Site, Thornton North Penrith Pty Ltd ACN 600 628 644 and this policy applies to the legal owners and their associates ("we", "us" or "our").

This Privacy Policy and Disclaimer applies to our collection of information and your access to the collected information when you transact with us on the Site and also on any forms or other means of collection of information by us. It also applies to the use of the Site.

When we refer to **personal information** we mean information or an opinion about you, from which you are, or may reasonably be, identified.

Due to the nature of our business, this information may include (but is not limited to) your name, phone number, email address.

We recognise that any personal information we collect about you will only be used for the purposes indicated in our policy, where we have your consent to do so, or as otherwise required or authorised by law. It is important to us that you are confident that any personal information we collect from you or that is received by us will be treated with appropriate respect ensuring protection of your personal information.

2. Privacy Policy

We are bound by the National Privacy Principles (the "Principles") contained in the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) as amended (the "Act"). The Principles can be viewed at the web site of the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner: www.oaic.gov.au. This Privacy Policy sets out our policies regarding the collection, use and disclosure of certain information relating to your use of the Site.

We recognise the importance of protecting your privacy and our Privacy Policy is designed to assist you in understanding how we collect, use and safeguard the personal information you provide to us, and to assist you in making informed decisions when using the Site.

This Privacy Policy is dated September 2014. As we update and diversify our products and services, this Privacy Policy may evolve. Please check this page for updates periodically.

2.1 Collection of Information

We have several areas where you can submit information to us, and we also have features that automatically collect information (e.g. cookies) from the users of our Site.

Registration: When you visit or transact business on our Site or one of our Display Villages, you may be required to register with us or be requested to provide us with personal and account information such as your name, account number, address, telephone number, e-mail address, subscription details (i.e., particular types of markets or property types on which you request information), and any other information that personally identifies you or would permit us to contact you. When you register with us, if you do not provide all the information requested by us, we may not be able to provide you with our services.

Cookies: We use what are commonly called cookies when you use our Site. A cookie does not identify you personally but it does identify your computer. We use these cookies to enable us to monitor traffic patterns, to serve you more effectively if you revisit our website or in the provision of information to you via the web. We may also use cookies to help us facilitate any promotions or surveys that we provide.

We may also collect information from any other document which you submit to us in connection with your expression of interest or your acquisition of an apartment in Thornton North Penrith. From time to time we may also offer other products and services.

While you may be entitled under the Act to transact with us without identifying yourself or using a pseudonym, we reserve the right to refuse to provide services or deal with you without you identifying yourself to our reasonable satisfaction.

Where reasonable and practical we will collect your personal information only directly from you. However, we will also collect information about you from third parties such as from our contractors who supply services to us, through our referrers, from a publicly maintained record or from other individuals or companies as authorised by you.

2.2 Use of information collected

We will use the information collected in order to:

keep you informed about our latest news, products and services, and to this end we may contact you using the details that you provided to us while registering on our Site;

respond to comments and questions;

provide customer support services;

generate internal reports;

instruct our associates; and

communicate with you information about the status of Thornton North Penrith and other information that may be of interest to you in respect of your expression of interest, or the delivery of your apartment in Thornton North Penrith

2.3 Disclosure of information collected

To enable us to maintain a successful business relationship with you, we may disclose your personal information to:

organisations that provide products or services used or marketed by us, (eg customer/support services);

companies and contractors who we retain to provide services for us, such as IT contractors, call centres, stationery printing houses, mail houses, storage facilities, lawyers, accountants and auditors, who will need to have access to your personal information to provide those services;

people considering acquiring an interest in our business or assets; and

other individuals or companies authorised by you.

By providing us with your personal information, you consent to us disclosing your information to such entities without obtaining your consent on a case by case basis.

Legally compelled disclosure: We will also disclose your personal information when required to do so by law, for example, in response to a court order or a subpoena or other legal obligation, in response to a law enforcement agency's request, or in special cases when we have reason to believe that disclosing your personal information is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone who may be causing injury to or interference with (whether intentionally or unintentionally) our rights or property.

We may from time to time transfer personal information outside Australia in accordance with the Privacy Act to countries whose privacy laws do not provide the same level of protection as Australia's privacy laws. For example, we may transfer your personal information to Europe, the USA or Asia. We may also use cloud storage and IT servers that are located offshore.

By providing us with your personal information, you consent to us disclosing your information to entities located outside Australia and, when permitted by law to do so, on the basis that we are not required to take such steps as are reasonable in the circumstances to ensure that any overseas recipient complies with Australian privacy laws in relation to your information.

2.5 Direct Marketing

From time to time we may use your personal information to provide you with current information about mortgage loans, special offers you may find of interest, changes to our organisation, or new products or services being offered by us or any company we are associated with. By providing us with your personal information,

you consent to us using your information to contact you on an ongoing basis for this purpose, including by mail, email, SMS, social media and telephone.

If you do not wish to receive marketing information, you may at any time decline to receive such information by contacting our Privacy Contacts using the contact details below. We will not charge you for giving effect to your request and will take all reasonable steps to meet your request at the earliest possible opportunity.

2.6 Security

We endeavour to protect the security of your personal information and your choices for its intended use. We store your personal information on a secure server, and use procedures designed to protect the personal information we collect from unauthorised access, destruction, use, modification or disclosure. We reserve the right to store your personal information in physical form, and we will make all commercially reasonable efforts to ensure that personal information stored or transferred in physical form is protected from misuse, loss, unauthorised access, modification or disclosure, and that the personal information is stored securely.

When the information is no longer needed for any purpose for which the information may be used or disclosed, it will be destroyed or permanently de-identified.

2.7 Access to Information, Accuracy of Information and Complaints

You have the right to have access to the personal information we hold about you. You can also request an amendment to this personal information should you believe that it contains inaccurate information. Should you wish to obtain access to or amend the personal information that we hold, please contact our Privacy Officer (contact details below) who can give you more detailed information. For security and confidentiality reasons, we will require you to verify your identity and specify what information you require. A fee may be charged for providing access, which will be advised in advance. We will not charge you a fee to update the personal information we hold about you.

The Act entitles us to refuse a request to access information in particular circumstances (such as specified business purposes or imperatives, and for law enforcement reasons). Where we do not uphold your request, we will inform you of the reasons for our decision in writing. If the information we hold about you changes, we ask that you contact our Privacy Officer (contact details below) so that we may update our records.

Any complaints may be made to our Privacy Officer (details below) or to the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner: www.oaic.gov.au. We will use our best endeavours to deal with any complaint by investigating the complaint, and providing a response to the complainant within 15 business days, provided that we have all necessary information and have completed any investigation required. In cases where further information, assessment or investigation is required, we will seek to agree alternative time frames with you.
